■ **Design Technology:** a soaring, light-filled workshop where students design and build real objects in timber, backed by a 3D-printing prototyping studio.

■ **Digital Technology & STEM:** a Fab Lab where digital ideas become physical objects, using the same tools as real designers and engineers — plus a covered outdoor learning area.

■ **Visual Communication & Design:** a gallery-like studio opening onto a landscaped courtyard, with a dramatic raked ceiling and wall space for students to display their work.

■ **Science:** a fully refurbished laboratory where every student gets their own workstation and sink, making practical science genuinely accessible to all.

- **Central Learning Area:** a generous open learning area with operable walls — teachers can open it up or divide it to suit any lesson.
- **Visual Arts Studios:** two dedicated Textiles and Media Arts studios with raked timber ceilings that absorb sound and create a warm, gallery-like atmosphere.
- **Flexible Learning Spaces:** large, reconfigurable spaces that promote collaboration, small and large group learning, and build student confidence.
- **Integrated Learning:** purpose-built small group and seminar rooms with carefully designed acoustics, supporting cross-disciplinary, science-integrated learning.
- **Shared Courtyard:** a landscaped courtyard at the centre of the hubs — a place to gather, reflect, eat lunch and connect.
